# People

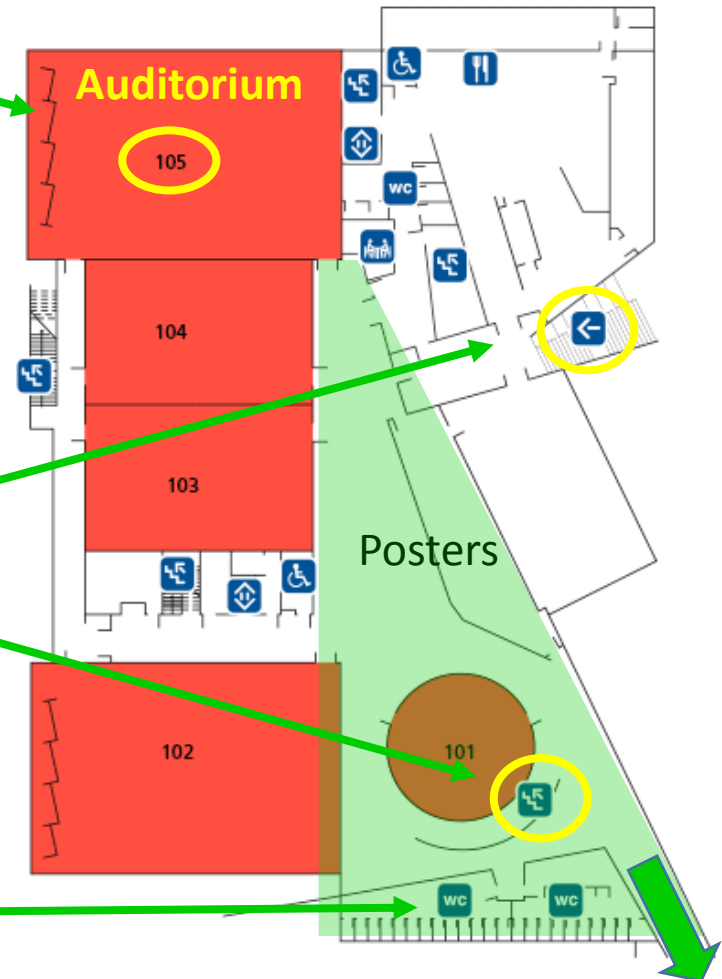


- CP Reykjavík: Imma, Kristjana & Co
